## MESSAGE FROM THE MINISTER

### Faith Is A Verb

*"We walk by faith, not by what is seen."  
St. Paul ~ 2 Corinthians 5:7*

St. Paul was not naïve. He knew that there were plenty of examples of injustice and evil. He knew that people often choose selfishness over selflessness. He knew, too, that the world is unpredictable and potentially dangerous. His joy was not a cheerful obliviousness to the widespread suffering of Creation. His joy was a faith, not in the mixed evidence of goodness in the world, but an active hope in the omnipotent love of God.

St. Paul taught that faith is a verb. Faith is not the result of reasoning things out with the intellect to determine what one believes. Faith is how we walk each day of our lives. And walking with God is not established by the evidence of things that we have seen, such as blessed lives and answered prayer. We don't walk with God because it makes everything turn out better for us. We walk by faith in God because there is nothing higher in the world that we can give our lives to than to this unconditional and omnipotent love.



Walking by faith means doing faith. We do faith by joining our church community in worship, in praying for one another, and in serving one another through love. Life happens. It's not realistic to always be in church every time the doors are open. But walking by faith does mean that we are making an effort to participate in the gathered community of worship. It is so important to greet one another in person whenever possible, to sing hymns, hold hands, and pray together for our church and our world.

Walking by faith means waiting on God. The use of the word "wait" in this context is like waiting on tables. It's not sitting around until something happens. It is work. It is service. There are so many opportunities in our church to serve, to wait upon

God. Prayerfully look for your opportunities to serve here at Pilgrim Church and in our local communities. Faith in God is a walking faith!

### *The Choir's on Vacation*



Music Sunday on June 2nd will mark the end of the Pilgrim Choir's 23/24 year and the choir will be going on a summer hiatus. That doesn't mean music will not accompany worship services this summer. Our music director Susan Winckler and organist, Bruce Jones will be trading off playing our beautiful organ accompanied by a soloist to lead hymns. We will look forward to the choir's return on Rally Sunday, Sept. 8th.

Though we may not see many of our choir members during the hiatus they can often be found singing while on their summer adventure. **Patrick Blackwell**, after being personally requested by the L.A. Philharmonic conductor, Gustavo Dudamel, was cast as Don Fernando for the opera "Fidelio." They will be performing at the Gran Teatre del Liceu Barcelona in Spain and at the Philharmonie de Paris in France.

"Fidelio" is the only opera composed by Ludwig van Beethoven. "This innovative semi-staged production was created for both deaf and hearing audiences. Explained through the composer's own music and the expressive gestural poetry of sign language, the performances explore the sublime communication that lies at the heart of all artistic expression." 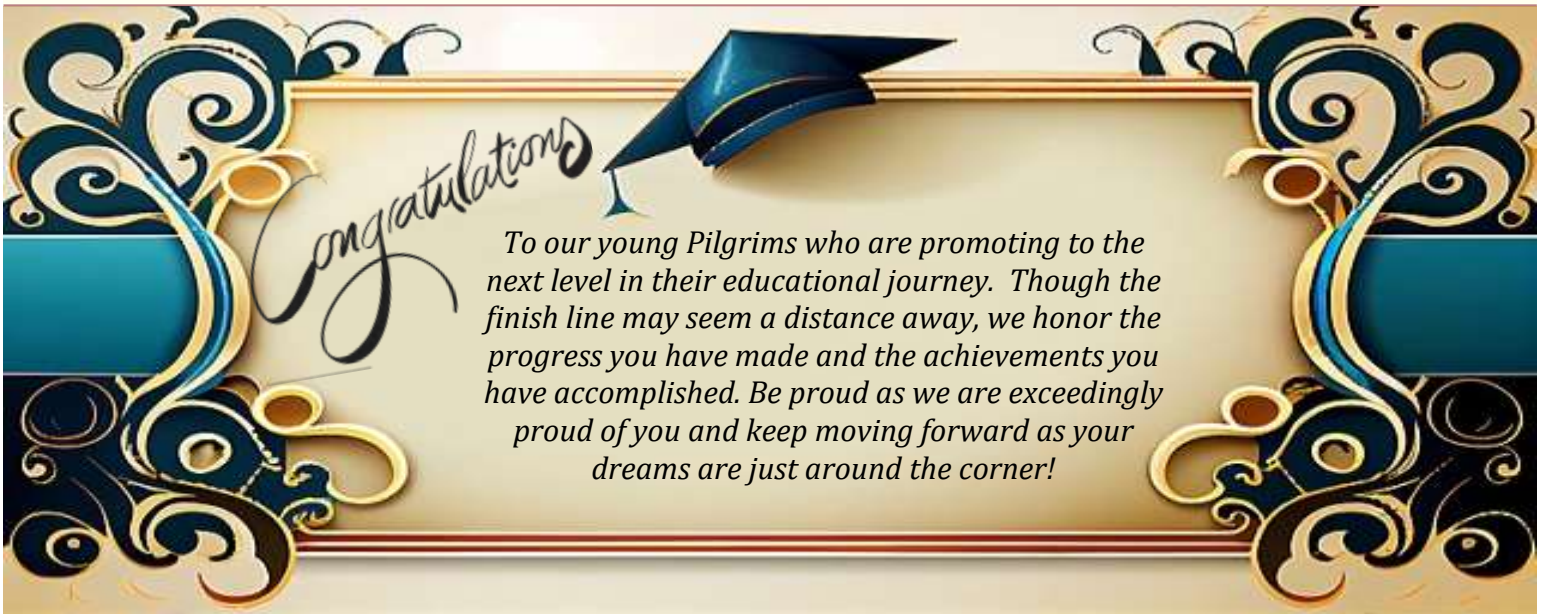
