MESSAGE FROM THE SENIOR MINISTER

The Lord's Grief

"Jerusalem, Jerusalem ~ Luke 13:34

One of the repeated themes in the Bible is a father's grief over a wayward son. King David deeply grieved the death of his son, Absalom, even though Absalom had sworn to kill his father. David's own servants and soldiers were shocked and offended when David publicly mourned the death of Absalom. Those servants did not understand why David expressed such strong feelings of love for a son who had so thoroughly betrayed him.

In the parable of the Prodigal Son, the father is deeply grieved when the youngest son asks for his inheritance and goes off to another land. His grief is relieved when the younger son returns, so much so that he throws a party. The older son is not happy about this, at all. He doesn't understand why his father would so willingly open his arms to the return of the wayward son.



In Luke 13, we have an account of Jesus grieving over the city of Jerusalem. The words, "Jerusalem, Jerusalem," remind us of King David's cry for his son, "Absalom, Absalom." Jesus seems to already be aware that the city and its leadership are going to put him to death. His response is not anger or retaliation; his response is the grief of a parent.

God's love for us is so radically unconditional that no matter what we do, we cannot escape that love. Just as King David's love for Absalom did not make sense to the servants and the love of the father for the Prodigal did not make sense to the older son, God's love for us does not make sense. This love grieves the heart of God when we break that relationship.

MESSAGE FROM THE MODERATOR

from the Moderator



Please continue to pray for our church and its leadership as we plan and move toward our future. There will be a number of opportunities to assist in the activities and ministries of the church and to introduce our friends, neighbors, and family members to the church as we move into and through the spring months. Remember that we do not pray to change God's mind. God wants the church to touch and change the lives of people. God wants the church to grow. We pray in order to align ourselves with God's plan. Listening is a part of our communication with God. We "listen" through reading and meditating on God's word, through watching and listening to the people around us, and, believe it or not, through participating in the worship of the church and listening to sermons. Your presence and participation makes a difference in the services of the church.

We will begin our observance of the Lenten Season on Wednesday, March 5, with our Ash Wednesday Service. This has become one of my favorite services of the year. It does not have the largest attendance, nor is it one of our most elaborate services. It is a quiet service, when we read passages from the Bible, when we read the words of hymns, and meditate on what Jesus did for us and on our commitment to Jesus. When we are ready, we go forward and receive communion from the minister, and when we are ready, we quietly leave. It has never been an easy service for me to get to. My work takes me all through western San Bernardino and Riverside counties, and I never know for sure when or where my work day will end, but I make every effort to get to the church before the Ash Wednesday service ends, because I have come to value that time of silent meditation and contemplation. The message of Christmas merits more than one day of reflection, so we observe the Advent Season. The messages of Good Friday and Easter Sunday merit more than two days of reflection, so we observe the Lenten Season. I would encourage you to try the Ash Wednesday service if you haven't before.



1. Go to the Raise Right website - www.raiseright.com or download the RaiseRight app.
2. Click Join a Program
3. Enter Enrollment Code: 535323LC11L99 (case sensitive.) This code allows the profit from the sale to be applied to Pilgrim.
4. Create your personal account following the steps.
5. Go to Account in upper right hand corner.
6. Payment Options is located on left side. Strongly suggest you use a credit card and add the information at check out.
7. Order items and follow steps to place and check out your order.



Liturgical Notes by Rev. Dr. Patrick Horn:

Purple was originally associated with royalty because it was a more expensive color to dye, and it was used to welcome the coming of a king. It also evokes pain and suffering. Purple symbolizes fasting, faith, patience, and trust. It is the liturgical color used during the seasons of penance, Advent, and Lent. For Advent, purple symbolizes the impending birth of Jesus while foreshadowing his death.


