## MESSAGE FROM THE SENIOR MINISTER

## Church, State and the Easter Message

"We must obey God rather than any human authority ~ Acts 5:29

One of the themes that we have noted in Luke is the stark contrast between the power of Jesus and the power of the state. Jesus' power consists of healing, casting out demons, and other miracles of empathy and compassion personally performed by Jesus for those in his social circles. The state's power includes Roman oppression of ordinary people through a corrupt tax system, legalistic restrictions placed on the people by religious authorities, and violence against anyone who speaks against the authorities, such as the execution of John the Baptist by Herod Antipas.

The contrast is striking. The authorities wielded the power of state institutions; Jesus did not. The authorities used the power of the state to force compliance; Jesus used the power of love to heal and offer forgiveness.

Some Christians are convinced that if we could just get the state to do what God wants, we could create a much more wonderful society. As a result, these Christians believe that God's kingdom can be brought to earth through the power of the state. But this completely misunderstands the New Testament and the revelation of God in Jesus Christ. God's love does not operate according to the power of state authorities to force compliance. God's power is love and love logically cannot force compliance with love.

Luke, writing in the book of Acts, continues this theme when telling the story of Peter and the apostles, arrested and brought before the Council. Why did they continue their practice of teaching in the Temple and persuading people to follow Christ when the authorities had jailed them and ordered them to stop? Because they must obey God rather than human authorities.

There are important differences between good and bad human authorities, but Easter did not happen through the power of any human authority. God was revealed in Jesus' teachings, his love, and his death on the cross. That is not a matter of policy; that is a matter of Spirit, a relationship of love.

## MESSAGE FROM THE MODERATOR



### Myth Busting—Myth #1, I won't be missed.

Every Sunday, the pastor has a sermon prepared. He has been working with the text for more than a week. He has reviewed the passages chosen in the lectionary for that Sunday, and has chosen readings from both the Old and New Testament. He has chosen the passage on which the Sermon will be based, and selected his theme and topic. He has addressed the text with church members and

friends in the daily devotions and weeknight Bible study. He has done even more study and reflection on his own. Every Sunday the pastor is ready.

Every Sunday, hymns and special songs have been selected. A prelude and postlude have been prepared. The musicians and singers have practiced, and they are ready.

Every Sunday an order of worship has been prepared, a worship assistant will present the Scripture readings that have been selected and someone will present a children's sermon.

Every Sunday, everything will be better if you are present. I have been involved in leading worship in churches for a long time. Take it from me, those who are in the chancel know where you usually sit, and as they work to make eye contact with the congregation, they are looking for you. When you are in your place, smiling, and ready to sing, pray, and listen, those in the chancel feel a little better, and are empowered by your presence, your prayers, and your support. The pastor's sermon delivery will be better, the music, will be better, the other members of the congregation will feel the difference your presence makes. When you are not present, you are missed.

## Myth #2, My opinion doesn't matter.

This is the time of year when members are asked to be part of the various boards and committees which plan and organize the worship and work of our congregation. If you are asked to consider being part of a board or committee it means that we do want to hear your opinion. Any church member can attend a meeting of the church council and express an idea, or "speak out" item to be considered. When we have a formal meeting or an informal "town hall" meeting your voice is heard. This is an important season in the life of the Pilgrim Congregational Church. We will be having board, Council, and Congregational meetings where important decisions will be made for the future of our church. Your presence, your voice, and your participation are important and will make a difference.



Bonus: while crossing off items on your to do list you help support Pilgrim Church ministries at the same time. You can make orders, or refill cards at the Raise Right website or download the app and register through your phone or tablet. See instructions below:

- 1. Go to the Raise Right website www.raiseright.com or download the RaiseRight app.
- 2. Click Join a Program
- 3. Enter Enrollment Code: 535323LC11L99 (case sensitive.) This code allows the profit from the sale to be applied to Pilgrim.
- 4. Create your personal account following the steps.
- 5. Go to Account in upper right hand corner.
- 6. Payment Options is located on left side. Strongly suggest you use a credit card and add the information at check out.
- 7. Order items and follow steps to place and check out your order.

The profits from each order will apply to Pilgrim Church once a month. You will be responsible for any charges (shipping/transaction fees.) Raise Right customer service is available to assist as well. If you have any questions, please call the church office at 909-622-1373.



**Liturgical Notes by Rev. Dr. Patrick Horn:** 

**Purple** was originally associated with royalty because it was a more expensive color to dye, and it was used to welcome the coming of a king. It also evokes pain and suffering. Purple symbolizes fasting, faith, patience, and trust. It is the liturgical color used during the seasons of penance, Advent, and Lent. For Advent, purple symbolizes the impending birth of Jesus while foreshadowing his death.

**Red** is the color of sacrifice and is used during Palm Sunday, Holy Week, Pentecost, and the feasts of the apostles and the martyrs.

**White** symbolizes purity, innocence, and birth. It is associated with the brightness of the heavens during daytime and was used to symbolize the purity of heaven and the angels. It also came to be associated with joy, celebration, and peace. White is the Liturgical color of Christmas, Epiphany and Easter.
